#### The Delta Blue Jays – Building Champions



The Merriam-Webster dictionary has four definitions for 'Champion':

- 1. Warrior
- 2. A militant advocate or defender
- 3. One that does battle for another's rights or honor
- 4. A winner of first prize or first place in competition

It's interesting that it's the last definition that describes being a winner.

This certainly is the most common understanding of being a champion. But while this definition describes what is essentially an outcome, it is the other ones that describe the behavior and attitude that are needed to achieve the outcome.

The Delta Blue Jays slogan 'Building Champions' embodies the concept of acquiring the behavior and attitude needed to be a champion. The score at the end of the game reflects who the 'winner' is. And those who do best within the context of the rule's 'win' the contest. Being a champion doesn't guarantee that you will win. But putting in the effort to develop the behavior and attitude of a champion will greatly improve your chance for success.

While we speak of this in regards to the great game of baseball, becoming a champion on the field will lead to success not only on the field, but to other aspects of life as well. One does not become a champion in anything without a commitment and discipline to hard work and a focus on improving performance. These three things, commitment, discipline and hard work, are the 'building

blocks' upon which a champion is built.

John Wooden, the legendary UCLA basketball coach had perhaps the greatest insight into the concept of building champions. Despite being the winningest NCAA basketball coach of all time, Coach Wooden never talked about winning to his team. To him it was all about being successful. He defined success in this way: 'Success is peace of mind which, is a direct result of self-satisfaction in knowing you did your best to become the best you are capable of becoming.' 'Building Champions' is all about learning to become the best you are capable of becoming, on and off the field. If you have not ever read Coach Wooden's 'Pyramid of Success' you would be well advised to do so if you are serious about becoming a champion.

A few final words of advice from the 'Coach':

'Don't measure yourself by what you have accomplished but by what you should have accomplished with your ability.'

'Be more concerned with your character than your reputation. Your character is what you really are, while your reputation is merely what others think you are.'

'Never mistake activity for achievement.'

'If you get yourself too engrossed in things over which you have no control, it will adversely affect the things over which you do have control.'

### Delta Jays capture prestigious tourney in Kamloops

B.C. Premier Baseball League frontrunners showcase outstanding pitching to capture Best of the West Invitational

An outstanding start to the 2022 season now includes a prestigious tournament title for the Delta Blue Jays.

Riding a B.C. Premier Baseball League (BCPBL) best 12-3 record into Kamloops, the Jays went unbeaten in five games to capture the Premier Showcase Division at the Best of the West Showcase Invitational.

An all BCPBL championship game on Sunday saw Delta rally to defeat the Victoria Eagles 5-2.

Trailing 2-0 in the sixth, Malakai Dubreuil came through with a clutch two-out hit to tie the game and three more runs followed.

The Jays' pitching, which was outstanding throughout the

tournament, took over from there with terrific work from Noah Thomas, Noah del Rosario and Noah Bourgeois.

Delta opened the playoffs with a 10-2 victory over Académie de Baseball du Canada, based out of Quebec.

Winning pitcher Hayden Cuthbertson was superb, striking out 10 in just under five innings of work with his fastball hitting 90-mph. The offence was led by Kyle Heburn and Bourgeois with two hits apiece.

Round-robin play started with a 2-1 triumph over the North Shore Twins. Everett Swaim started on the hill, followed by Thomas with a big hold, and Ryan Heppner finishing it off.

Kenny Scott, had a big game going 2-2 with a triple and a double.

Delta then defeated Big League Experience 3-0 behind Carson Latimer's two-hitter over five innings. He also struck out seven. Kyle Matsunuma had a pair of hits.

The semi-final berth was secured with a 2-2 tie against Alberta's Vauxhall Academy. It was Heppner's turn to shine on the mound and he didn't disappoint, striking out eight in five innings while showcasing his 90-mph fastball.

#### Extra innings....

-The Delta Jays' Bantam Prep team also enjoyed a strong showing in Kamloops, reaching the semi-final of the Bantam Premier Division before falling to eventual champion Langley Blaze. Delta currently sits second in league play with an 8-2 record.

# Former Blue Jays ace Francis elected to the Canadian Hall of Fame



Left-hander Jeff Francis was elected to the Canadian Baseball Hall of Fame in 2022.

Francis, who played with the Delta Blue Jays in 2001 will be inducted in June with the class of 2020 that includes former players Justin Morneau, John Olerud and Duane Ward along with Montreal Expos broadcaster Jacques Ducet.

Francis spent 11 seasons in Major League Baseball, including eight with the Colorado Rockies. Francis also played for the Kansas City Royals, Cincinnati Reds, Oakland Athletics, New York Yankees and Toronto Blue Jays, compiling a career record of 72-82 with a 4.97 earned-run average in 254 career contests.

"I was so excited to get the news from the Hall of Fame of my induction," Francis said. "When I see the list of people and players that I will be joining on the walls in St. Marys, I'm honoured and humbled to be considered on that level. "This is not something that is ever in an athlete's mind during his or her playing days but in the time since my last days of playing, I've become proud of what I accomplished in baseball. I consider this not just recognition of my achievements in the game, but of the coaching, mentorship and support I've received from so many other people."

"Jeff Francis is one of the greatest lefthanded pitchers to come from Canada," said Jeremy Diamond, the chair of the Canadian Baseball Hall of Fame's board of directors. "He was the ace of the Colorado Rockies on their National League pennant-winning team in 2007 and is considered one of the best pitchers in Rockies' history.

"He has also answered the call to play for his country whenever he has been available and is a wonderful ambassador for baseball in our country."

#### **Building Champions for 28 years**



Canadian ballplayers continue to make their impact felt in various leagues across North America, and similarity among them is that many played in the Premier Baseball League for the Delta Blue Jays.

Founded by Mike Kelley, and Ari Mellios in 1995, the Jays originally played other club teams throughout BC and the US. This year marks the 28th Season for the (North) Delta Blue Jays. Over the past twenty-eight years, the Jays have offered high school-aged players the opportunity to play competitive baseball against the best players throughout British Columbia and the Pacific Northwest. In 1999, the Jays and five Lower Mainland club teams joined with the six-team Island Premier Baseball League. A year later, the league became the British Columbia Premier Baseball League (BCPBL) and expanded to its current 13-team format, that includes Junior Premier and Bantam Prep levels.

One of the Delta Blue Jays' main goals is to prepare players for the next stage of their baseball career, wherever it may be. Alumni litter past and current rosters in the NCAA, NJCAA, NAIA, NWAACC and CCBC conferences.



Senior Assistant Coach, Brody Hawkins, also played for UBC from 2011- 2015 and former Senior Jay, Ryan Heppner joined the Varsity Thunderbirds in 2022 and his brother, Sean join UBC in 2020. Kyle Matsunuma also joined Ryan and Sean at UBC on baseball Scholarships in 2022. "The BCPBL has always been the top high school-aged league in the country, and UBC has enjoyed a great relationship with the BCPBL,

it's coaches, and players over the years," said UBC's former Director of Baseball Terry McKaig. "Having the top players in the province in the same league, playing against each other, is the reason so many great players have developed over the years."

The 'Building Champions' across the back of our practice jerseys isn't just a valueless motto – it's exactly what the program does.

They often mention how the Delta Blue Jays program played a crucial role in making the desire to play baseball at a high level a reality. Players from all eras of the program have thrown around the words' work ethic' when discussing what they found most valuable from their time in Delta. In a 2012 interview with the website "Chasing the Dream," current Boston Red Sox James Paxton ('06) said that his work ethic came from Mellios, and former catcher and coach Jeff Hutton ('06) stressed how the program helped him not only






with baseball but with life as well. "Playing for the Blue Jays taught me how to push myself to work harder than I thought I was capable of. It turned me into a player that understood the game and how to play it the right way. It also taught me many of the subtleties of the game that I had previously been oblivious of. Learning all of the finer details about the game of baseball is what made me love the game more than I ever did growing up... Without the Blue Jays program, I don't know where I would be or what I would be doing by this time in my life." Over these past 28 years, both the players and teams have enjoyed considerable success. The 1998 club was elected into the Delta Sports Hall of Fame in 2008, while the 2010 senior team was named BCPBL Team of the Year. The 2019 season saw two Provincial Championship titles for our teams and ended with the Senior Jays winning Bronze at Baseball Canada's 18U National Championships in London, ON. In 2022 our Premier team won the league regular season tying the best overall record in PBL history. Our Bantam team won the 15U National Championship. As for individual successes, among the many who played at the professional, university, or college level, a few who stand out. Chase Larsson ('06), who received the Tino Martinez Award as the top player in NCAA Div II in 2012, and Jimmy Van Ostrand ('02) who played for Team Canada at the World Baseball Classic.

Three players to put the PBL on the map came out of the Delta program: Justin Morneau ('99), Jeff Francis ('99), and James Paxton ('06). A left-handed pitcher nicknamed "The Big Maple", Paxton was drafted by the Seattle Mariners in 2013 and threw a no-hitter against the Toronto Blue Jays in 2018 (becoming the second Canadian to reach that achievement). He currently pitches for the Boston Red Sox. Drafted out of high school in the third round by the Minnesota Twins in 1999, Morneau was the American League MVP in 2006 and officially retired in 2018 after 14 MLB seasons. As for Jeff Francis, he was taken ninth overall out of the University of British Columbia in the 2002 draft by the Rockies. His best season came in 2007 when he went 17-9, helping lead Colorado to the World Series where he started Game 1. In 2015 he rejoined the blue and white, signing with the Toronto Blue Jays.

Whatever path a player takes after their time with the Blue Jays, it's typically one towards success. While the MLB might not be the endpoint for each alumnus, opportunities to play ball at the college level also mean an opportunity to receive an education, which can lead to a profession in various fields; in the case of Malcolm Boehm, Brennen Flodin, Declan Murphy and Cam Frick, it may mean coming back to the coach and pass on their wisdom.

# Delta Blue Jays are 15U national champions

The City of Delta has its first minor baseball national champion in decades.

The Delta Blue Jays capped their dream summer by capturing Baseball Canada's 15U Ray Carter Cup in Saskatoon with a 4-2 victory over Quebec in Sunday night's gold medal game. Ironically, Carter is a longtime Tsawwassen resident and Delta Sports Hall of Fame inductee who served for many years on Baseball Canada's executive. Their home diamond at Winskill Park in Tsawwassen is also named after him.

Kotaro Kawai could not have picked a better time for his second home run of the season as he sent an 0-2 pitch just over the left field fence in the bottom of the sixth to break a 2-2 deadlock and send his teammates into a frenzy. Quebec had tied the game in the top half of the inning. Brodie Tse earned the save in the seventh after coming on in relief for starter Jake Fehr who was brilliant over six innings.

It was about eight years ago Tsawwassen Amateur Baseball's Wayne Laviolette approached Cam Frick about coaching a new Bantam AAA regional team. Under his guidance the Delta Tigers became a powerhouse in B.C. Minor Baseball, including a second place finish at the 2019 nationals. The team moved over to the B.C. Premier Baseball Bantam Prep League in 2020 and became an official affiliate of the PBL's Delta Blue Jays, with the name change happening this season.

The national final was the team's 91st game of the season, dating back to last fall.

"Our guys have worked so hard. I got to say I'm pretty demanding as a coach," Frick chuckled. "We play a ton of games. We practice more than anybody and we want to play the best teams. We want to challenge our guys and I think every year it seems we peak at the right time.

"We treat every game seriously and it helps us when we get to those big games. The guys were just so relaxed on (playoff) Sunday. We are about to play a national semi-final game (a 6-1 win over Manitoba) and the guys are joking around and got the (pre-game) speakers out on a Sunday morning. It was like we were playing in March against a local team at Winskill."


It's that cohesiveness that helped make a difference in a tournament that featured just three club entries and seven provincial teams selected specifically for nationals. Most cold weather provinces start their seasons later and play their club provincials in mid-September.

The Jays opened round-robin play last Thursday with a wild 7-6 win over Quebec in 10 innings. They were unable to close out a 3-1 lead in the seventh and international rules (runners on first and second) resulted in a flurry of runs in extra innings.

A 6-4 win over host Saskatoon set the stage for a semi-final clinching 8-5 win over Ontario on Saturday morning. Hunter McLean got the win on the mound and Smyan Billing's two-run homer in the first set the stage for a clutch offensive performance.

Langley Blaze pick-up Luke Laird was named the tournament's top defensive player. Chilliwack's Ian Vandepol was outstanding on the mound in the semi-final win.

The Jays roster also featured: Lucas Holt, Desmond Tregaskis, Noah Farnden, Jimmy Mellios, Nathaniel Kolmel, Sawyer Shears, Ivan Simbulan, Brayden Abenojar, Connor Fischer, Ed Wilde and Nathan Reynolds. Rounding out the coaching staff are Tim Fehr, Tim Frick, Christian Deane, Joe O'Krafka and pitching coach Dave Empey.

The Delta Sports Hall of Fame returned from a two-year pandemic pause to welcome seven new members as part of its 2023 induction class.

The legendary baseball player and coach Yogi Berra once said, "Little league baseball is a very good thing because it keeps the parents off the streets." For Hall of Fame inductee Gerry White, baseball has not only kept him off the streets for decades, but he has been a part of developing some of the best young people in Delta through sport.

Growing up in Ontario, Gerry learned to love baseball as a youth and played for several competitive seasons there. Gerry made his way out west to call Ladner his home and he began coaching with his own kids. Baseball was a family affair for the Whites — Gerry actually started coaching his daughter Lauren and

the South Delta Invaders ('97-'01) and then his son Brad with Ladner Minor Baseball Mosquito A team ('02).

For the past 25 years, Gerry White has been a head coach in baseball to some of Delta's best players and teams. Gerry has been a key part of putting Ladner Minor on the baseball map, leading them to provincial championships in '03, '05 and '06, Western Canadian gold in '05, Western Canadian bronze in '06 and a Canadian Nationals silver in '07. During this period, Gerry saw a need to create an "excel" program of giving extra practice sessions and skill development to players and made these sessions available for casual house players as well as the most competitive. The effect was Ladner had more young people playing baseball than ever and at a higher level. The excel program

Gerry initiated is a legacy with LMBA today.

From 2008-2017, Gerry was a head coach with the North Delta Blue Jays of the BCPBL and led them to a BCJPBL championship in '11 and '14. During this time, dozens of players went on to receive university scholarships and the (North) Delta Blue Jays program has had three players play in Major League Baseball. As Gerry reflects on his time as a coach, the most meaningful contribution isn't the wins and losses or championships, but being a part of the development of youth, watching them achieve, grow in confidence and become responsible and accountable people.

While Gerry is no longer coaching, he is the general manager for the Delta Blue Jays program, which is still keeping him "off the streets."




